ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff Stephen Sedlacko's Motion for Summary Judgment against Defendant Lindsey Dearborn and Motion for Summary Judgment against Defendant Lisa Law. A hearing and oral argument were held on the motions on July 5, 2011. Neither Defendant appeared in person or through counsel. The Court finds that the motions are well-taken and should be granted substantively. The Court further finds that, in the alternative, the motions should be granted for default for the failure of the defendants to appear. Wherefore, it is hereby ordered that:

1. The Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment against Lindsey Dearborn and motion for summary judgment against Lisa Law are granted.
2. The signatures of Lindsey Dearborn and Lisa Law in regard to the assembly of June and July 2009 in the State of New Mexico and commonly known as the Annual Rainbow Gathering are void and null. Defendants had no legal authority to sign on behalf of the Rainbow Gathering.
3. That the Defendants Lindsey Dearborn and Lisa Law had and have no legal authority to sign any legal documents on behalf of Plaintiff.
4. Defendants Lindsey Dearborn and Lisa Law are enjoined from signing any further
