STATEMENT UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY

COMES NOW, Adam Buxbaum who states under penalty of perjury:

1.

I am over 18 and competent to give this statement.

2.

I am attending the Rainbow Family gathering this week.

3.

I was stopped twice on June 17 and June 20, 2018, at the intersection of 28-1 and 77. As I drove down the road I encountered a stop sign down the middle of the road. I was asked for drivers license, registration and proof of insurance because it was a mandatory compliance checkpoint. I was directed to pull my car over to the

side of the road. They took a dog to search the vehicle when the dog allegedly alerted they told me to step out of my vehicle. They then proceeded to empty the car, putting the items on the road. They cut open a sealed box. The search lasted for 30 minutes. They broke open a cashbox.

The next time my vehicle in the backseat area was searched completely again because a passenger reached for her wallet. The search took 10 to 15 minutes.

I personally saw a Georgia resident stopped for 10 seconds and immediately let go.
