#### APA Petition, Demand for Rulemaking

Mr. Hubbard & Staff:

A year ago we presented a formal <u>PETITION TO AMEND</u> the USFS 'Noncommercial Group Use' regulation, 36 CFR 251.50- 251.56 – to remedy constitutional defects precluding a broad class of citizens from fair special use review and lawful authorization in public assembly.

We sent a substantial package– with surgical *Code Amendments* enabling 'Operating Plans' for public assembly, proposed *Interpretive Rule* points in support, a definitive legal *Memorandum* on Group Use policies, and suggestions on expediting the *Rulemaking Process*.

To date we have seen no responsive action from your office or the RHVR Staff.

The "right to petition for the issuance, amendment, or repeal of a rule" is not a discretionary matter: It mandates the Agency's proper and transparent acceptance, timely public notice and review of the proposed rulemaking, and a clear determination on the merits. 5 U.S.C. §553(b), (c), (e).

The failure to conduct such proceedings violates the Administrative Procedure Act.

•• Submitted herewith are signed Public Petitions protesting the abuse of these regulatory powers, and calling for the CFR revisions & applied policy reforms we propose: [4 Series, 2014-18... 25 Pages – 194 Signatures]

These were collected casually as this project evolved... it is only the beginning of this campaign: With a solid APA Petition now on the table, there will be broader support from concerned citizens & organizations, and active inputs in the public record as the requisite process goes forward.

*PCU*•*Free Assembly Project* has moved this initiative on compelling public interests to protect rights on public lands, enact workable special use policies, and end the pointless stalemate & strife.

We expect prompt acknowledgement from the Under Secretary's office, and a proper *"Workplan"* on this proposed regulatory action from the RHVR policy staff. DR 1512-1, §3d.
